

What will I be doing this term?

In literacy we will be learning about:

- Characters and settings.
- Different types of poetry.
- Exploring grammar.
- Biographies and different forms of non-fiction writing.

In numeracy we will be learning about:

- Place value up to 1000.
- Addition and subtraction of up to 3 digit numbers.
- Expanding our mental maths abilities.
- Exploring shapes and measures.

In science we will be learning about:

- Healthy eating and how to keep our bodies healthy.
- Identifying that all animals need the right diet and amount of nutrition.
- Identify that some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

In geography we will be learning about:

- How to use an atlas.
- Location of Spain.
- We will be studying Madrid and its culture including food.

In history we will be learning about:

- The Stone Age in Britain. What tools were used and how they lived.
- The Iron Age in Britain. What legacy they left behind. Some of their customs and how they lived.

In computing we will be learning about:

- We are learning to create comic strips.

- We will use different software to create different images and evaluate them.
- We will refine and evaluate our comic strips.

In art we will be learning about:

- We will be studying various Spanish artists such as Joan Miro, Picasso and Gaudi.

In Design and Technology we will be learning about:

- How to design a moving monster and explore materials and techniques to make the monster.
- How to work as a team to build a project.
- How to evaluate our ideas.

In music we will be learning about:

- Exploring music from different cultures.
