

WHAT WILL I BE DOING AT SCHOOL THIS TERM?

In line with the National Curriculum for Year 6, this gives an overview of some of the work being carried out in Year 6 this Autumn Term.

In English we will be using the films ‘Goodnight Mister Tom’ and ‘Harry Potter’, and looking at:

- Narrative writing
- Newspaper reports and recounts
- Descriptive Poetry
- Non-Chronological reports and other non-fiction type texts
- Grammatical agreement and construction of different sentence structures
- Dictionary and thesaurus work to encourage VCOP
- Knowing antonyms and synonyms.
- Spelling will be linked to word families

In Mathematics we will be covering:

- Angles
- Reading and Interpreting scales
- Adding and Subtraction , Multiplication and Division and applying these to worded problems
- Properties of 2D shapes
- Language of lines
- Measuring
- Conversion/Translating in different contexts
- Graphs and Pictograms

Focus on mental maths, times tables up to 12 x 12 and mental strategies

In R.E. our topics are:

- Domestic Church – Family / Loving
- Baptism and Confirmation – Belonging / Vocation and Commitment
- Advent and Christmas – Loving / Expectations

In Science our topics are:

- Electricity
- Evolution
- Light and how we see things

In History our topic is:

- Turning points in World War II

In Geography our topic is:

- London – the tourism industry and its landmarks

In Art our topic is:

focuses on watercolour techniques and includes work on London landscapes and war inspired paintings linking in to both our history and geography topics

In Music our topic is:

- Flutes
- Songs of WWII
- Christmas
