Farewell to Year 6

After a truly wonderful year, it is time to say a fond farewell to our Year 6 pupils, wishing them all the best in their new schools, and their future, although they will be dearly missed. The children have gained some fantastic friends, funny memories, as well as some great SATs achievements - Latest figures show that 86% of pupils achieved at least one subject at Expected Standard, 81% of pupils achieved at least two subjects at Expected Standard, and 76% of pupils achieved at least Expected Standard in all three subjects of Reading, Maths and GPAS. Although, unofficially the threshold for Above Expected Standard has not been given, using the 2016 threshold (110 scaled score) the following pupils gained above expected standard in all 3 subject areas, well done: Abel B, Adam H, Anjy P, Brianna A, Christo D, Elizabeth G, Miguel L and Shirel M.
